Using Bluing in Swimming Pools

Using Mrs. Stewart's® Bluing in Swimming Pools

One of the other uses for Mrs. Stewart's® Bluing is to brighten the blue color in swimming pools.

How to use MSB in Swimming Pools: We are told that the best way to use MSB in a swimming pool is to put 1-2 bottles of bluing into the pool at the point where the water enters the pool from the filtration system. Give the pool 1-2 hours to thoroughly circulate the bluing throughout the water. This is for a pool approximately 20' x 40'. Sunlight will eventually diffuse the blue out of the water. Add another bottle of MSB when the color begins to fade.

MSB shouldn't affect the chemical process you are already using for your pool. We have not had any "pool" customers report any kind of negative chemical reactions in their pools as a result of using MSB. It is used in pools simply to make the color brighter. It should not be used as a substitute for the chemicals recommended by your pool manufacturer.

Facts about MSB: MSB is basically a blue iron powder suspended in water and contains a non-toxic amount of a biocide and pH balancer. Even in its concentrated form, MSB is non-toxic, biodegradable and environmentally friendly. MSB is manufactured under non-sterile conditions and is therefore, not generally recommended for ingestion by human or animal.

Disclaimer: MSB is manufactured and tested as a laundry whitener only. All other uses are "at your own risk". While we advertise MSB for some other uses, we try to remain clear that these other uses come to us from loyal customers and we pass the information on as a public service.

We DO NOT recommend using MSB in an aerated pool like a jacuzzi, hot tub or whirlpool. The reason is because the bluing particles tend to cling to the outside of the bubbles, travel to the sides of the tub, and, depending on the absorbency of the material of the tub, leave a permanent blue "ring around the tub".
